

## Spallacci Group donates \$250,000 to new athletic complex at Hillfield Strathallan College

Hillfield Strathallan College (HSC) has recently announced a \$250,000 donation from local builder Spallacci Group for its Transformation HSC campaign, bringing the total funds raised to more than \$34 million. This gift is the latest in a series of significant donations, including recent additional commitments of \$6 million from Michael G. DeGroote and \$500,000 from alumna Judith King-Siganski '62.

This generous donation, along with the total giving of \$19 million from the DeGroote family, more than \$1 million from King-Siganski and other significant gifts from the Hillfield Strathallan College community, means HSC will break ground on their new Athletic Complex and Community Centre in February 2013.

The new Athletic Complex and Community Centre is part of the school's Transformation HSC campaign – an exciting \$42 million project which will see a reinvestment in HSC's current facilities on a scale not previously seen in the school's 112-year history. Adding approximately 134,000 sq.ft. of space, the new buildings will transform not only the campus, but the way in which HSC is able to deliver the

quality education on which it prides itself.

“Transformation HSC is a vision which inspires and enables all of our students to pursue their individual passions, be they academic, artistic, or athletic. We are committed to providing the programming and spaces that develop the leadership potential of every HSC student. Transformation HSC allows us to do that in new and dynamic ways,” said Head of College Marc Ayotte.

The Spallacci family is pleased to join the numerous other families who have contributed to be a part of the transformation of the Hillfield Strathallan College campus.

“Our mission is to build quality, value and relationships with our clients and partners. Supporting our community is part of that tradition,” said Frank Spallacci, who together with his brothers Rudi and Loren run the highly respected Spallacci Group.
